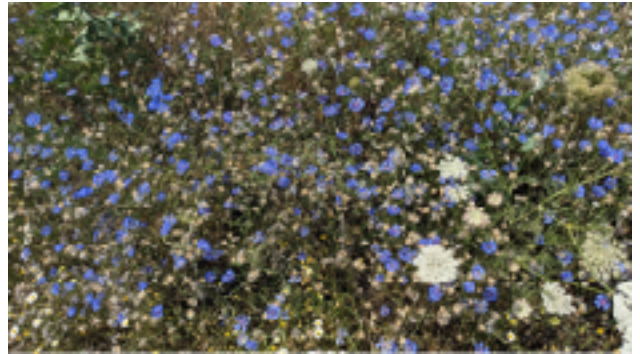


Praying at Priestfield
